City of Taylor Proposals

- **Recall Proposal**
 - Shall Jeffrey Lamarand be recalled from the Office of Mayor?

Huron Schools Proposals

- **Operating Millage Renewal Proposal**
 - This proposal will allow the school district to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2012 tax levy.

Northville Public Schools Proposals

- **Operating Millage Renewal Proposal**
 - This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Van Buren Public Schools Proposals

- **Operating Millage Renewal Proposition Exempting Principal Residence and Qualifie**
 - This millage will allow the school district to continue to levy not more than the statutory rate of 18 mills against non-principal residence and non-

qualified agricultural property required for the school district to continue to receive its full revenue per pupil foundation allowance.
